The Neighbourhood Policing Team for the above areas are PC 717 Sarah WHITEHEAD and PCSO 7038 Helen HOUGHTON. We are joined regularly by a dedicated team of Special Constables.

The 'other offence' figures cover domestic crimes and incidents, theft and violence offences. These offences vary from month to month.

Theft from motor vehicles continue to be a problem this month. Though it is an issue across Northampton with no specific pattern. We would urge all residents to ensure that their properties and belongings are secure when unattended and that doors are kept locked whether or not you are at home.

Please be mindful of distraction burglaries, if you are not expecting visitors; please consider not answering the door, or perhaps answering from a first floor window.

Our team's #BlueButterfly key messages are:

- We all have the right to feel safe, all of the time.
- We can talk with someone about anything, even if it feels awful or small.
- We all have a responsibility to respect the rights of others to feel safe.

We would ask that the adults on the area work alongside us, respecting and reinforcing these simple messages to both young and older residents.

We would ask if residents wish to report anything at all, that they call **101** for non-emergencies or **999** for crimes in progress or life threatening situations.

For those who do not wish to report incidents directly to the police, we would ask that you contact **CrimeStoppers** on **0800 555 111** – these are a totally independent crime-fighting charity who can be contacted anonymously via the aforementioned number or online at www.crimestoppers-uk.org. No personal details are taken, information cannot be traced or recorded and you will not go to court.

We encourage all residents to report anti-social behaviour via 101 (whether or not you need an officer to attend) as it helps us to plan our patrols and to be in the right areas at the right time.

Anti-social behaviour isn't only caused by 'young people' – if you are affected, please do let us know.

Anti-social behaviour includes but is not limited to:

- Disruptive, noisy behaviour in otherwise quiet neighbourhoods.
- Night time noise from houses or gardens, especially between 11pm & 7am.
- Threatening, drunken or 'yobbish' behaviour.
- Vandalism, graffiti and fly-posting.
- Dealing or buying drugs on the street.
- Litter and fly-tipping rubbish.
- Aggressive begging.
- Drinking in the street.
- Setting off fireworks late at night.
- Abandoning cars on the street.
